- 3.0 Educational Qualification: Different educational qualifications are prescribed for various posts. For further information, please refer to the detailed CEN to be published on the official websites of RRBs.
- 4.0 Candidates should ensure that they possess / fulfil all eligibility conditions prescribed for the post(s) as on the closing date for Submission of Application. CANDIDATES WAITING FOR RESULTS OF PRESCRIBED EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION SHOULD NOT APPLY.
- 5.0 Medical Standards: Candidates must ensure that they fulfil the prescribed Medical Standards for the post(s) for which they are applying, as detailed in the CEN published on the official RRB websites. Candidates found medically unsuitable for the applied post(s) shall not be given any alternative appointment.
- 6.0 Reservation and suitability for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) : For further information refer to the detailed CEN to be published on the official websites of RRBs.
- 7.0 Reservation for Ex Servicemen (ExSM): For further information, refer to the detailed CEN to be published on the official websites of RRBs.

10.0 Examination Fee:

2.	For candidates who belong to SC, ST, Ex-Servicemen, PwBD, Female, Transgender, Minorities or Economically Backward Class (EBC). This fee of Rs.250/-shall be refunded duly deducting bank charges as applicable, on appearing in the CBT.	Rs.250/-		

NOTE: Only candidates who attend CBT will get a refund of their examination fee as mentioned above:

- 11.0 Candidates are required to go through the Post Parameter Table and Vacancy Table of detailed CEN 02/2024 to ascertain their eligibility before applying through ONLINE mode. Each candidate is allowed to apply to only one RRB for a specific pay level, and only one common ONLINE application should be submitted by a candidate for any or all of the notified posts within that pay level, in order of preference. Applications should be submitted only through any of the official RRB websites listed in Para 13 below. A separate application must be submitted for each Pay Level, as a separate CBT will be conducted for each Pay Level. The applicable Examination Fee is also required to be paid separately for each Pay Level. Once the selection of RRB is made, it shall be final for that pay level. Applying to more than one RRB for the same Pay Level by a candidate will result in the rejection of all applications for that Pay Level and debarment.
- 12.0 Eligibility: Eligibility of the candidates will be provisional based on the details furnished by the candidates in the application. Candidates must satisfy themselves that they are eligible for the post. If at any stage of recruitment or thereafter, it is found that any information furnished by the candidate in his / her application is false / incorrect or the candidate has suppressed any relevant information or the candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria for the post(s), his / her candidature will be rejected forthwith.
